



The Department of Agriculture - Bureau of Agricultural Research (DA-BAR) approved and funded two current research projects at USMARC, namely: “Effects of Pests, Diseases, Biocontrol, and Weather on the Phytochemical Production of Coffee and Cacao in Mindanao” and “Nutritional Analysis of Indigenous Vegetables and Wild Edible Fungi as Affected by the Occurrence of Pests, Diseases, and Weather Factors” with a total allocated budget of P10.67M for two years. Half of this budget was already released to USM as initial funds for the first year of implementation of both projects.
